


What is Rotary?



Rotary was First! That's right, we were the very first service club in the world. We were formed in 1905 by Paul Harris, a Chicago attorney who envisioned a new kind of club for professionals that would kindle the fellowship and friendly spirit he had known in his youth in Vermont.



Women: Today, there are approximately 90,000 women Rotarians worldwide, many of them serving in leadership roles. We eagerly encourage women to join us.

Minorities: There's no such thing as a minority in Rotary. We are a global organization that includes every race, creed, color, and religion.

Service: In 1985, Rotary made a historic commitment to immunize all of the world's children against polio. Since then, Rotary has contributed nearly half a billion dollars to polio eradication.


